- Be able to elicit patients understanding of CKD and where needed offer the following:
  - Explain the risk factors affecting the progression of CKD including but not limited to:
    - Cardiovascular disease
    - Hypertension
    - Diabetes
    - Smoking
    - Chronic use of Non Steroidal Anti Inflammatory Drugs (NSAIDS)
    - Untreated urinary outflow obstruction<sup>121</sup>
  - How can people cope with and adjust to CKD and what sources of psychological support are available?<sup>122</sup>
- o Provide patients with health promotion advice, taking into account their ethnicity, cultural, social and economic needs, including but not limited to:
  - Exercise
  - Achieving a healthy weight
  - Smoking cessation<sup>123</sup>
- o Be able to explain the type and frequency of the monitoring needed 124
