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 Smoking cessation.⁷² Be able to discuss the medications used in the management of CKD. Be able to explain the type and frequency of monitoring needed ⁷³ Be able to explain the steps to take prior to monitoring to ensure accurate results⁷⁴: Not to eat meat 12 hours prior to serum test for Creatinine. Where possible urine albumin/Creatinine ratio's (ACR) should be performed on an early morning urine. Review Be able to review the patient, following the care plan set by a Registered Nurse or GP, at the appropriate interval. Be able to perform the tests necessary to review CKD classification including: Serum Creatinine/eGFR test. Urine ACR. Be able to escalate the patients care to a Registered Nurse or GP where risk factors for the progression of CKD⁷⁵ are identified: Performing Blood Pressure (BP) review. Investigating for Diabetes Mellitus. Smoking status and providing cessation advice where appropriate. Chronic use of NSAIDs. Any issues with urinary flow. Be able to participate in the review of results and ensuring patient receives follow up from a suitable senior clinician where appropriate. Be able to administer appropriate vaccinations, under a Patient Specific Direction (PSD), to patients with CKD as per local and national guidance.⁷⁶ Be able, in conjunction with a suitable senior clinician, identify where patient requires onward specialist referral.⁷⁷ Be able to recognise when patient complexity exceeds competence and refer on as appropriate.
